The workshop offers multiple opportunities to **participate**, **network** and **present** your organization to the Community. Use your presence at the workshop to raise your profile.

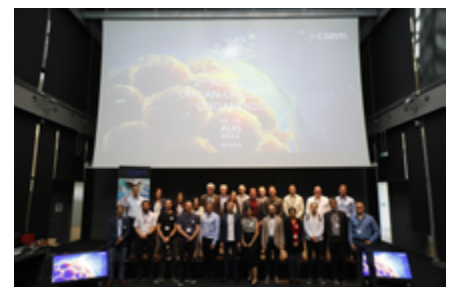
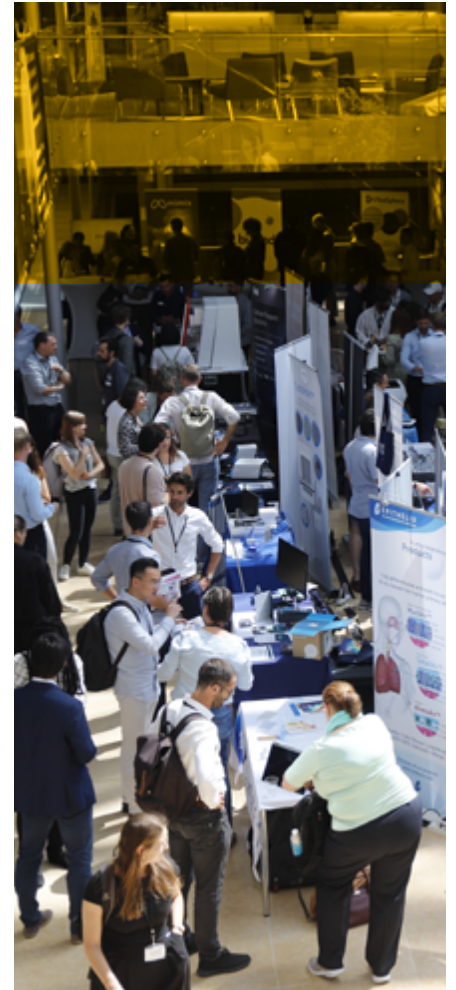

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF BOOKING

1. Deadline for registration is set on the July 31, 2023.
2. Acceptance of applications for sponsorship and exhibition is at the discretion of the organizers.
3. Cancellations: If you find it necessary to cancel your exhibition or sponsorship package, please contact our team immediately by email (btu@csem.ch).
 - a. Cancellation more than 60 days prior to the first open day of the conference – 100% reimbursement of the payments (no penalty).
 - b. Cancellation between 31 and 60 days prior to the first open day of the conference - penalty of 50% of the total charge provided that written notice is received.
 - c. Cancellation 30 days or less prior to the first open day of the conference – 100% of the total charge as a cancellation penalty.
4. In case of cancellations by the organizers, all payments will be reimbursed.
5. Payment must be made in advance of the conference and is non-refundable according to the above cancellation terms.
6. You will be provided with confirmation of your booking, along with full details of electronic material providing deadlines such as logos or flyer ad.
7. The exhibition stand contract constitutes a license to exhibit and not a tenancy. The organizer reserves the right at any time and from time to time to make such alterations in the ground plan of the exhibition as may in their opinion be necessary in the best interests of the exhibition and to alter the shape, size or position allocated to the exhibitor.
8. The exhibitor or sponsor shall not be entitled to withhold payment of any amounts payable to the organizer in relation to the exhibition or sponsorship package by reason of any dispute or claim by the exhibitor or sponsor in connection with the exhibition/sponsorship package or otherwise nor shall the exhibitor or sponsor be entitled to set off any amount which it is alleged is payable or due from the organizer against any amount payable to the organizer in relation to the exhibition or sponsorship package.
9. Exhibitors are responsible for their own insurance for the event.
10. Exhibitors are responsible to transport their materials to the exhibition area and set their booth on time on their own.
